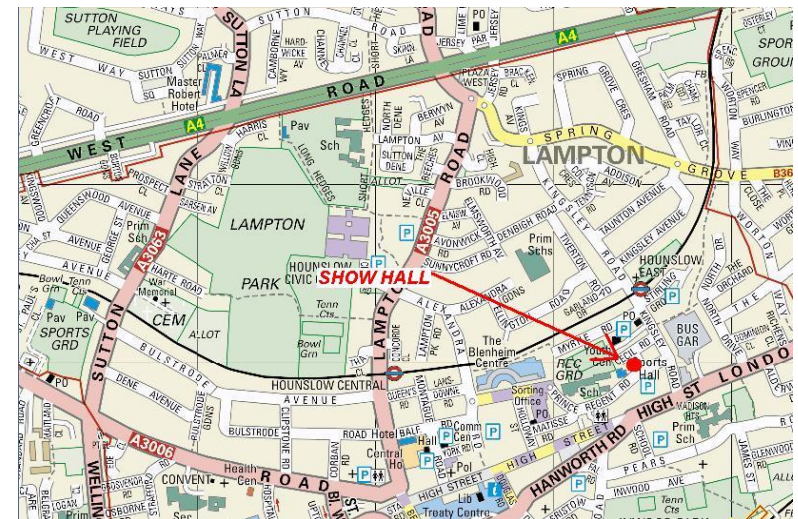

Breeders Classes: Teams of four fish, bred by the exhibitor, not more than fourteen months old on the day of the Show. **Date of birth to be shown on the Entry Forms,**
