FREE ENTRY TO ALL CLASSES

Closing date for post or e-mail Entries: Wednesday **14th August 2013**

NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY ALLOWED (EXCEPT FOR SUBSTITUTIONS IN THE SAME CLASS)

Breeders Classes must be teams of four fish not more than fourteen months old on the day of the Show. Date of birth must be shown on the entry forms, and the fish must have been bred by the exhibitor.

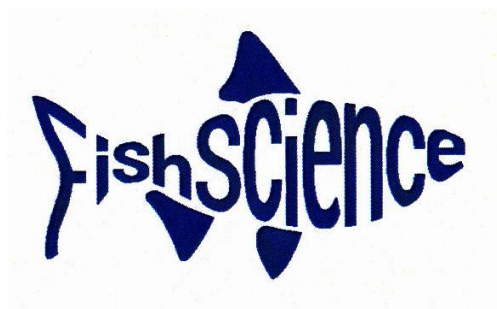

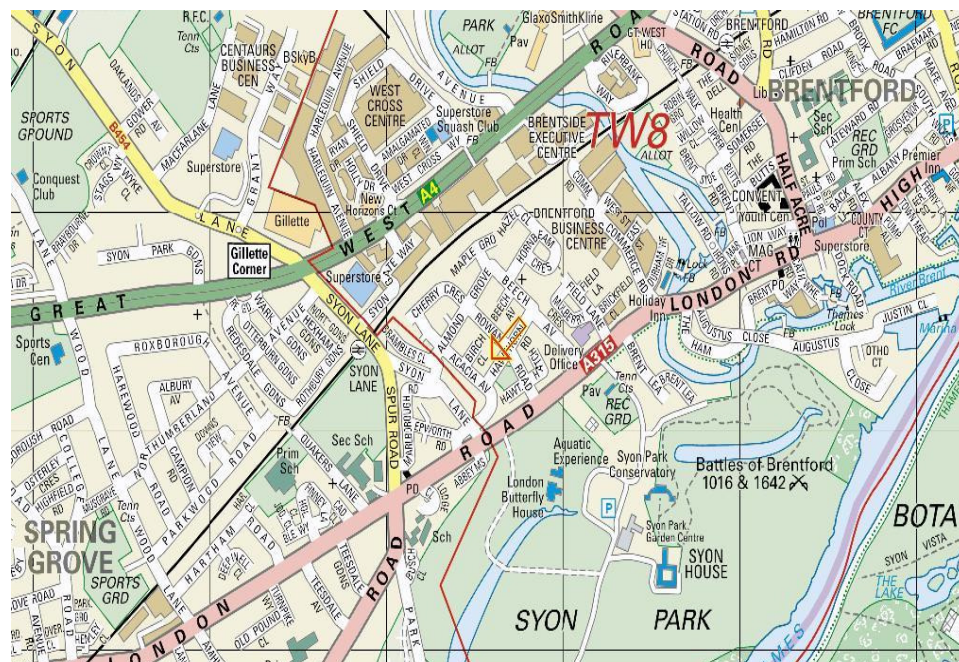
